What we learned:

Today, the children learned that it is important to seek wisdom. Although gaining wisdom can be a difficult process, the benefits are well worth it. The children were challenged to seek God's wisdom and to remember that all wisdom comes from God. (Scripture used: Proverbs 2:1-6)



Memory Verse:

"For the Lord gives wisdom; from his mouth come knowledge and understanding."
Proverbs 2:6 NIV

Discuss what wisdom is and why it is important to seek Godly wisdom. Practice this verse several times with your child during the week.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Make a treasure hunt out of reading the Bible, read Psalms and Proverbs together with your child. Each time your child reads or hears the word "wisdom" have them call out "I have found some more of God's treasure!" Explain how they can apply the scripture to their life.

Dear Lord, Please teach us to accept your word, to store up your commands within us, turn our ear to wisdom, and apply our heart to understanding! Let us be diligent in our quest for godly wisdom and let us search for wisdom as we would for gold or other treasures. Amen.
