This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today, we learned the importance of obedience and why it is important to obey parents, teachers, and especially God. It was God who told Noah the earth would be destroyed, but he and his family would not be harmed. Noah and his family were saved from the flood. This happened because Noah and his family were obedient to God's command to build and enter the ark. (Scripture used: Genesis 7:1-10; 13-16)

Memory Verse:



"This is love for God: to keep his commands. And his commands are not burdensome, for everyone born of God overcomes the world." 1 John 5:3-4a NIV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help him or her remember the verse but it will also help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Along with your child, create a simple game that both of you can play. Agree on rules for the game. An example may be to name different kinds of animals, but the name must have the letter 'R', like alligator, raven, etc. Explain why games are more fun with rules.

Discussion questions:

What would happen if our rules were not obeyed?
Why is it important to be obedient?
