To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What We Learned:

Today your child learned how he or she could be like Jesus by lending a helping hand to others. When we treat others more importantly than ourselves, and serve willingly, God is very pleased. Your child also discovered there are many different ways people can serve God, and all are important. (Scripture used: John 13:4-17)

Words to Remember:

(Bible versions used are selected to help young children learn and understand the meaning of scripture.)



**"Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children."
Ephesians 5:1 NLT**

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Choose a category, and with your child alternate naming different jobs that fit that category. Here are some suggested categories:

1. Jobs where people wear uniforms: *(Police officer, soldier, nurse, hotel workers, etc.)*
2. Jobs where the person drives a vehicle: *(Police officer, mail carrier, taxi driver, etc.)*
3. Jobs that require a lot of training: *(doctor, lawyer, professor, etc.)*
4. Jobs where the person may get dirty: *(gardener, miner, auto mechanic, painter, etc.)*



Jobs can fall into more than one category. Whoever cannot think of another job in any category loses that round. Throughout this activity, explain to your child how there are so many different jobs that affect people in different ways. Whatever job we have, we should do it as if serving the Lord.
