What We Learned:

Words to Remember:

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child remember the verse and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Take a walk outside with your child. Point out all of the beautiful vegetation that you see, and remind your child that God makes it possible for all of it to grow. Ask your child what would happen if you cut a flower from the garden or pluck a leaf off a tree. Allow time for discussion. Just as the leaf withers and dies when separated from the branch, we wither spiritually if we do not stay connected to Jesus. Those who remain in Jesus will bear fruit.
