To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What We Learned:

Today your child learned that to be like Jesus, he or she must love others with the same love shown by Jesus. Jesus loves us so much He even gave up His life on the cross so we might have eternal life through Him. Your child also discovered that love comes from God. To know God we must have love, and when we love others, God lives in us.

Words to Remember:

(Bible versions used are selected to help young children learn and understand the meaning of scripture.)

"Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ." Ephesians 5:2a NLT

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Early in the week, purchase a sheet of heart stickers. Sit down with your child and read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 from the Bible all the way through once. Then, read the passage again stopping on each word or phrase that describes what love is or is not. After stopping on each word or phrase, discuss with your child what it means to show love in that particular way. Then, throughout the week, any time your child demonstrates love in any of the ways described in the Bible passage, give him or her one heart sticker.



Daily Prayer:

Dear Lord, thank You for loving me and showing me how to love others. Let Your love show in my life every day in the things I do, in what I say, and in how I think. Thank You Jesus for loving me so much that You gave up Your life so I may live with You someday in Heaven. Amen.
