## To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



## What We Learned:

Today, your child learned how he or she could pray boldly and ask God to provide for his or her needs and the needs of others. Your child also learned different ways to treat others that will help show God's love. (Scripture used: Luke 11:5-13)



## Words to Remember:

(Bible versions used are selected to help young children learn and understand the meaning of scripture.)

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child to remember the verse and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.



## Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Review the memory scripture with your child. As a family, make a list of things you can ask for from God. Remind everyone that you are practicing being bold. There is no prayer too small, too big, or too crazy for God. He just wants you to ask Him first. Once you have a good list, pray as a family and believe that God will answer your prayers in His timing and according to His will. When you receive an answer, be sure to remind your child about the time you prayed about it.
