What we learned:



Today we learned that we are brought from spiritual death to spiritual life when we receive salvation. In addition, our physical lives on earth will be drastically changed when we have a growing faith in Jesus. Because of Jesus' death we have life! Even though physical death is a reality in our world, we can know the eternal, living hope that comes from believing in Jesus. God restores us to Him when we receive salvation. Sin leads to death but faith in Jesus brings life!

Memory Verse:



“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Romans 6:23 NIV

Read the verse to your child. Then help your child come up with several ways to excitedly “cheer” the verse. You may clap, stomp, or dance if desired. Perform the verse together and create new cheers until the verse is familiar.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Tell your child about a time when you were separated from a favorite pet, friend, or possession. Describe how the separation made you feel and ask your child how they feel to be separated from something they love. Admit that separation of any kind is hard but being separated from God for all eternity is the worst separation of all. But the good news is we will be restored to Him when we believe in Jesus! We don't have to fear separation because we know God will care for us and do what He's promised.
