What we learned:



Today, we learned the importance of living a righteous (just) life and how we must always allow God to lead us through the difficult times we will encounter. When we trust in the Lord, He will always help us through these difficulties, as he did for Joseph, the husband of Mary. God chose Joseph to become Mary's husband because he was a just man and a descendent of King David. (Scripture used: Matthew 1:18-24)

Memory Verse:



"Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;" Colossians 3:12 KJV

Continue to practice this verse several times with your child during the week. Ask your child how he or she can show these qualities this week at home, at school, and at church.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Read through the generations of Jesus as found in the book of Matthew, chapter one. Then work on a family tree of your own. Start with your child's grandparents, or great grandparents, and work your way down to show all the family members your child is familiar with. Compare this to the generations of Jesus, and discuss how significant it is that the Bible contains this information.
