To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today, your child learned about the wise men and their quest to seek Jesus so that they could honor Him with gifts and worship. Our story from Matthew chapter 2 challenged our students to look for Jesus and use every opportunity to remember Him and His birth this Christmas! He is worthy of our praise, gifts, and time! Of all the characters of Christmas, the wise men set the best example of pursing Jesus with our whole hearts through studying God's Word and giving generously to Jesus because He is worth it! (Scriptures used: Matthew 2:1-12)

Memory Verse:



"But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul." Deuteronomy 4:29 KJV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child remember the verse and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Have your child set aside a little bit of money from his or her allowance or piggy bank each week. Take the money and place it in a paper bag labeled "For Jesus." Talk about how money is what is used to buy things—fun things like candy and toys but also important things like coats and clothes. Encourage your child to take the money they collect and give it to Jesus in the offering at church on Sunday. Explain that when we give money to church or to help someone in need, Jesus is honored! In this way, your child is worshipping Jesus with something that costs him or her and that is what generosity is all about! The wise men did not just give gifts that they did not want or like—they gave gifts that cost them greatly. We honor God when we give up something we love for someone we love even more—Him!
