To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today the children learned that truly believing in Jesus also means to have an intimate and trusting relationship with Him. As Jesus' disciples spent time with Him, we can also spend time with Him through prayer, reading His Word, and letting Him be Lord of our life. (Scripture used: John 14:1-14)

Memory Verses:



"And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God." John 6:69 KJV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help him or her remember the verse, but it will also help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

1. With your child, look up the meaning of the word intimate. Check several sources so your child will have a good idea of the meaning.



2. Ask your child to name the people he or she feels most comfortable being with. Then have your child rate them from 1 to 10 to show how intimate they are with them. For example, Mom or Dad as a 10, and a close friend 7, and a new friend perhaps a 2 or 3.

3. Finally, discuss what number your child would give to Jesus. What can someone do to become more intimate with Jesus? What would being very intimate with Jesus be like, feel like, and look like?

Heavenly Father, help me to have an intimate, meaningful relationship with You. Thank You for making Yourself real to me in Your Son Jesus, and for all the wonderful ways You show Your love. Let me grow even closer to You, so others will see Jesus alive in me. Amen
