To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What we learned:



Today, your child learned that God wants all of us to keep our promises. We should not swear by Heaven, earth, or anything else. Your child also learned that there are consequences to breaking promises, and he or she discovered the value in keeping his or her answers simply yes or no. (Scripture used: Matthew 5:33-37)

Memory Verse:



"But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil." Matthew 5:37 KJV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child remember the verse and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Read Matthew 5:33-37 together as a family. Make big "Yes" and No" signs to put on the refrigerator door. When someone in the family makes a promise, have him or her write it out, sign it, and put it under the yes or no sign. This is a great way to hold each other accountable in keeping our promises.

Thank You Jesus for setting the standard on how to have a godly reputation. You kept every promise You made. Help me be a promise keeper. Remove any stains that I might have caused from lying, breaking promises, or making excuses. May the Holy Spirit teach me to be a person that is trustworthy and honest. Amen.
