What we learned:

At times, it may be easy for your child to worry about the speck of dust in someone else's eye, but never notice the plank in his or her own eye. (Scripture used: Matthew 7:1-5)

Memory Verse:



"Judge not, that ye be not judged." Matthew 7:1 KJV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child to remember the verse, and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Read Matthew 7:1-5 together as a family and then discuss a time when you judged someone unfairly. Next, read James 4:12 and discuss who is the real Lawgiver and Judge, while we, thankfully, are not. Finally, read Galatians 5:14 and discuss how we are supposed to treat our neighbors.
