What we learned:

Today, your child learned that Jesus came to seek and save the lost. Your child also learned how his or her testimony about Jesus will help others believe Jesus is the Savior of the world. (Scripture used: John 4:4-30, 4:39-42)

Memory Verse:



"For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." Luke 19:10 KJV

Read Luke 19:10 together as a family and then ask your child the following questions:

- 1. Who is the Son of Man? (Jesus)
- 2. What did He come to do? (To seek and save the lost.)
- 3. In context of this passage, what does it mean to be lost? (To be separated from God.)
- 4. How does Jesus save us? (Jesus died on the cross to pay for our sins and restore our relationship with God.)



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Share your testimony on how you came to know the Lord, with your child. Explain how sharing our testimonies with others can be sort of a map to help people begin their own relationship with Jesus. Knowing that Jesus still actively seeks and saves the lost will be encouraging to many people.

Dear Lord, we are thankful that You sent Jesus into the world to seek and save the lost. We thankful that Your love crosses all boundaries, places, and people groups. We rejoice that your love for us cannot be contained. Amen.
