To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What we learned:

In today's lesson, the children saw how God works for the good of those who love Him. We learned how God helped Joseph through some very difficult times because he chose to follow and honor Him. (Scripture used: Genesis 37:3-28; 39:1-6)



Memory Verse:

"He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the Lord shall be made fat. Proverbs 28:25 KJV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Over the next few weeks, read the entire Biblical account of Joseph's life with your child (*Genesis 37-47*). As you read the scripture point out each of the ways in which God helped Joseph through difficult times. Discuss Joseph's reactions to his troubling times and how we can apply these same attitudes to our lives today. Explain to your child that success comes from the Lord and that God works things out for those who love Him. Sometimes growing up can be hard. Ask your child to share some of the difficult things that are going on in his or her life. Discuss how God uses these things for his or her benefit. Share examples of how God has used difficult situations in your life to help you grow.



Daily Prayer:

Dear Lord, we thank You for loving us and for taking care of us in so many different ways, ways that we cannot even imagine. Lord, may we be like Joseph and trust You in both good times and bad. Amen.
