What we learned:

Today's lesson was about the time Joseph helped Pharaoh by telling him what his dreams meant. The children learned how God uses people in mighty ways when they choose to follow Him. In addition, the children saw that it is God's Will to provide whatever abilities we need to carry out His purpose. (Scripture used: Genesis 41:1-39)

Memory Verse:



"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Joseph told Pharaoh that his dreams were a warning. After seven years of feast, there would be seven years of famine. Pharaoh put Joseph in charge of saving food from the abundant years so the people would have enough to eat during the famine. Help your child learn the principles of "saving for a rainy day" by helping him or her set aside something for the future. Perhaps start a food pantry, a savings account, or a place to keep warm clothing for the winter. Help your child understand that God is able to provide whatever we need to carry out His purpose, but that may also mean saving some of what He provides for the future.
