To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned in Sunday school today. In addition, you will find this week's memory verse, a suggested activity, and a short prayer to reinforce the lesson. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What we learned:

Today the children discovered that genuine love comes from God, and having Godly love means we will show kindness to all people, even our enemies. It takes a very powerful kind of love to love even our enemies. That kind of love only comes from knowing Jesus. (Scripture used: Luke 10:25-37)



Memory Verse:

"Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, **doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil**; Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things." **1 Corinthians 13:4-7 KJV**

The children continued memorizing 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, today concentrating on verse 5 (the portion in bold). Practice this verse several times with your child during the week in addition to the verse learned last week. Encourage your child to memorize the full passage if possible.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

One way to show loving kindness, even to an enemy is to pray for them. With your child, pray for someone who needs to know Jesus. It may be a bully in school, a mean neighbor, or even a political adversary. Earnestly pray for these individuals to find the true love of God in their lives.



Daily Prayer:

Dear God, thank You for showing Your love to us in so many ways. Thank You most of all for giving us Your Son Jesus, who loves us so much, He would even die on a cross to save us. Lord, help me to be kind, and loving to everyone, even to those who don't love me. Amen
