To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What We Learned:



Today children learned that God is holy and perfect. We can praise God's holiness by praying, singing, and reading the Bible to learn more about Him. Also, because God is perfect, He allowed Jesus to die on the cross to pay for our sins. When we trust in Jesus as our Savior then our sins are forgiven. (Scriptures used: Leviticus 20:8, Deuteronomy 32:3-4, Romans 6:22-23)

Words to Remember:

(Bible versions used are selected to help young children learn and understand the meaning of scripture.)



"He is the Rock, his ways are perfect, and all his ways are just." Deuteronomy 32:4a NIV

Read the verse aloud with your child. Then sing the first verse of the hymn, "Holy, Holy, Holy" to emphasize that God's perfection means He is holy. Practice this activity several times with your child during the week. This will not only help your child to remember the verse, but also it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Ask your child to accompany you on a grocery-shopping trip. As you gather items to purchase, talk about how each item has a price that must be paid in order to take it home. Contemplate with him or her how to pay for the items without money (such as receiving them as a gift or allowing someone else to pay for them). Help your child understand that the items are like sin, or the bad things we do, and require payment. Discuss the fact that Jesus is perfect; therefore He paid for our sins when He died on the cross. Because God is holy, He requires that we trust in Jesus as our Savior to pay for our sins so we may have a relationship with Him and go to Heaven.

Daily Prayer:

Only You are perfect, God. We know that You love us because You sent Jesus to die for us. Please help us remember to praise Your holiness through prayer, song, and learning the Bible. Amen.
